

Dear Provider:

We are writing you regarding an important announcement regarding your ID.me account. A new ID.me requirement called ENHANCED MEDICAL CREDENTIAL CHECK goes into effect Thursday, August 11, 2022. As a medical provider using ScriptSure Cloud E-Prescribing (Daw Systems, Inc.), you must perform this check. This check applies to you if you use ScriptSure as a standalone system or if it is integrated into your existing EMR. What is the reason for the ENHANCED MEDICAL CREDENTIAL CHECK?

ID.me is used in ScriptSure Cloud ERX to prove your identity when you created a login and it is used to approve controlled prescription orders. This requirement is to combat fraud and ensure the security and integrity of the electronic network. On your next login to ID.me, you will be prompted to enter your **NPI and DEA Number and DEA state.** When you submit your licenses, ID.me validates the licenses. You only need to do this once. If you have MULTIPLE DEA #'s, you will want to use the one registered in ScriptSure.

Who needs to do this?

Only providers that prescribe controlled substances.

What do you need and how long does it take?

You need your NPI number, DEA number and DEA State. The process takes approximately 2 minutes. The check is immediate after you enter the credentials.

Do you have to do this? What happens if you don't do the check?

Yes, all providers must do this. If the checks fail or the licenses are entered incorrectly, you can try again. If you continue to fail you can read the screen to complete a form for ID.me and they will check the credentials manually. If you do not do this, you will not be able to prescribe controlled substances until you do.

When can you do this?

You can click the button below to do the check **now** OR you will be auto-prompted



to do this on prescribing your next controlled prescription (on the next login to ID.me while prescribing).
